Call for 2024 AAAH Award

AAAHR Award Purpose

The Asia Pacific Action Alliance on Human Resources for Health (AAAHR) is a regional partnership mechanism established in response to international recognition of the need for regional and global actions to strengthen country capacity for Human Resources for Health (HRH) planning and management.

The AAAHR award was established since 2010 to recognize the outstanding performances and contributions of health professionals in the HRH field. The 13th AAAHR conference will be held in Lao PDR during 28th-31st October 2024 focused on "Building a Resilient Health Workforce and Preparing for Future Public Health Emergencies". In this regard, the AAAHR is accepting nominations for the 2024 AAAHR award.

There are 4 award categories including Primary Health Care Team, Health Profession Education, Digital Health, and Youth. One awardee per category will be selected to participate and give a presentation during the 13th AAAHR conference to showcase their initiatives.

Inclusion criteria

Nominees can be individuals, teams, organizations, or projects. They are not required to be a part of the AAAHR member countries, but their work or projects should have an impact in the Asia-Pacific region. They must meet the following criteria to qualify:

General inclusion criteria for all categories

1. Clear evidence of positive outcomes resulting from the nominees' work, including improvements in health services delivery, workforce efficiency, or health outcomes.
2. Having a lasting impact, potentially serving as best practices or models for replication.

Specific inclusion criteria for each award

1. Award for Primary Health Care Team

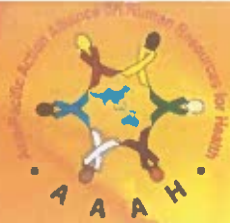
To recognize **teams** that have demonstrated excellence in providing comprehensive, accessible, community-based care, the criteria is specifically designed to honor collaborative efforts, innovation, and effectiveness in primary health care delivery.

- 1.1 The team must be composed of multidisciplinary professions
- 1.2 Working in community health systems for at least 2 years
- 1.3 Evidence of providing a broad range of primary health care services that meet the diverse needs of the community and improve health outcomes of the population.
- 1.4 Demonstrable effectiveness in teamwork and collaboration within the primary health care team, including clear roles, mutual respect, and shared goals.

2. Award for Health Profession Education

To recognize either **individuals or organizations** that have made significant contributions to the field of health professional education.

- 2.1 Development and implementation of innovative educational programs, tools, or methodologies that enhance learning experiences for health professionals.
- 2.2 Impact on public health officers or health professionals' knowledge, skills, and competencies, preparing them effectively for the health workforce.
- 2.3 Initiatives or programs that are sustainable beyond initial implementation, with potential for scale-up or replication in other contexts or regions.
- 2.4 Leadership roles in advancing health profession education at the national, regional, or global level.



3. Award for Digital Health

To recognize **projects** that have significantly advanced the integration and application of digital technologies in healthcare

- 3.1 The project introduces new or significantly improved digital health solutions, technologies, or platforms that address specific healthcare challenges.
- 3.2 Clear evidence of impact on how the digital health project has improved health outcomes, healthcare delivery, including making healthcare services more accessible, efficient, or cost-effective.
- 3.3 Demonstrates sustainability, with a clear plan for long-term operation, maintenance, and support of the digital health solution.
- 3.4 Strict adherence to data security and privacy standards, with robust mechanisms in place to protect sensitive health information.

4. Award for Youth

To recognize either **individuals or teams of young people** who have made significant impacts to overcome public health challenges faced by their community through innovation and leadership.

- 4.1 Being an agent of change to address the public health challenges.
- 4.2 Applicants must be under 35 years old (as per the UN youth definition).
- 4.3 Participation in community engagement or involvement in the decision-making processes for ensuring the transfer of experiences and knowledge between generations.
- 4.4 Demonstrate strong leadership qualities and the ability to inspire and mobilize peers, professionals, and community members in health-related initiatives.

Nomination Application Requirements (Recruitment phase)

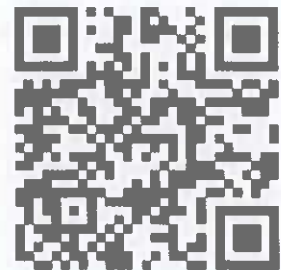
1. Nominee's contact details (Mandatory)
2. Nomination Form (Mandatory): Send out [Google form](#) (attached QR code) that indicates the nominee(s) meet all eligibility criteria specified for the award category. The form can be submitted by the nominees themselves or by a referrer.
2. Nominee's resume or CV (Optional during initial phase): Detailing relevant information about the nominee and specifying the work or project believed to align with the award criteria can be submitted in the Google form.
2. Award criteria Narrative (Optional): Limited to two typed pages. Offer specific details regarding the highlighted work or project.

Award Selection Committee

The award selection committee is comprised of HRH experts from external committees.

Nomination deadline

Every country whose work or projects have an impact in the Asia-Pacific region can nominate several candidates, including individuals, teams, organizations, or projects, for the 2024 AAAH Awards. Nominations and required documents should be submitted by **July 31, 2024**. They can send all documents to the AAAH Secretariat via email at aaahrh.net@gmail.com or through the Google Form.
